## Focus Texts



**Science** -What season is it and how do we know? Linking to settings of stories. Creating experiments to gather information about weather.

**Scientific Enquiry Skills**-performing simple tests

**Geography**-Stories from around the world

Making comparisons with our locality

What is it like in Kenya? What's the weather like in Barnstaple?

**History**- Castles, knights, Kings and Queens

Kings and Queens- Linking to story characters about Fairy tales
