

2025 / 2026 Nursery and School Dinner Prices



From September, the price of school dinners will be £2.50 per day, and nursery fees will be as follows: Age 2: £6.50 per hour Age 3 to 4: £5.50 Per Hour

We have made every effort to keep these increases to a minimal amount, and this only applies to paid meals and sessions. The usual entitlements for free school meals and funded nursery places will still be available to those who qualify.

PUNCTUALITY MATTERS!

Being frequently late for school adds up to lost learning:

- Arriving 5 minutes late every day adds up to over 3 days lost each year.
- Arriving 15 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 2 weeks a year.
- Arriving 30 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 19 days a year.

19 days lost a year through being late means 90% attendance.
