


Eden Park Academy Newsletter



Summer HAF Provision

The Summer Holiday HAF provision for Devon is now available to book, this is all done online via **eequ.org.** We are really pleased to be hosting

If you use the email address log in option, a code will be sent to the email address, which you then type in and it allows you access to the website. Type Barnstaple in the top search bar and all the local provisions come up. Select your preferred option and then select from the available dates

It will ask for your child's information, and then your own, as well an additional emergency contact

Your booking is then submitted to the council who check eligibility and will send you an email once your booking is approved. You no longer need your HAF code to book with the new system.
